



BID BULLETIN NO. 01 PROCUREMENT OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL UNDER CUSA 2021

18 March 2021

This Bid Bulletin is issued to reiterate certain items in the Bidding Documents and further clarify various concerns raised during the Pre-Bid Conference held last 17 March 2021.

The following are the questions raised and the response thereto:

- Q1: Relative to the Financial Bid Form (Financial Component) of the bidding documents, is there a standard form to be used for submission?
- **A1: Yes.** Bidders are advised to access and download the Bid forms/standard templates through GPPB website (www.gppb.gov.ph).
- Q2: How many copies will be submitted for the Technical and Financial Component?
- **A2:** The BAC reiterates Invitation to Bid (ITB) Section 7, paragraph numbers 2 and 3, to wit:

"For manual submission, prospective bidders must submit two (2) separate sealed bid envelopes at the JHMC Conference Room, JHMC Office Complex, Camp John Hay Baguio City. Lacking or additional documents not included in the sealed envelopes shall not be accepted.

Bid submission may be done through electronic means, provided that the same:

- a. uses a two-factor security procedure consisting of an archive format compression and password protection to ensure the security, integrity and confidentiality of the bids submitted;
- b. allows access to password-protected Bidding Documents on opening date and time. The passwords for accessing the file will be disclosed by the Bidders only during the actual bid opening which may be done in person or face-to-face through videoconferencing, webcasting or similar technology; and
- c. capable of generating an audit trail of transactions to ensure the security, integrity and authenticity of bid submissions.
- d. The first compressed file shall contain the technical component of the bid, including the eligibility requirements, and the second shall contain the financial component of the bid.

- Q3: Will the Notice to Proceed (NTP), Notice of Award (NOA) and Contract be attached as references to the Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts?
- A3: For the Statement of all ongoing government and private contracts, the prospective bidder need not attach the NTP, NOA and Contract. However, the bidder who will be subjected to post-qualification shall be required to submit the documents.

For the Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, the NTP, NOA and contract of the bidder shall be attached for validation purposes.
