RECOMMENDING AWARD FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THREE (3) RANGER STATIONS AT HAPPY HALLOW, LOAKAN AND HILLSIDE

WHEREAS, it is the task of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE), and to ensure that the JHMC abides by the standards set forth by Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as "The Government Procurement Reform Act" and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations, to all its procurement activities;

WHEREAS, the BAC received Purchase Request (PR) No. 2024-002 from the Environment and Asset Management Department – Project Management Division (EAMD-PMD) for the construction of three (3) Ranger Stations at Happy Hallow, Loakan, and Hillside. The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for this procurement is Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP2,200,000.00). A copy of the said request is hereto attached as *Annex* "A";

WHEREAS, in the approved JHMC Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for FY 2024, the purchase request falls under PAP Code of INFRA-2 with mode of procurement as Competitive Bidding;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted the bidding of the project and advertised the Invitation to Bid (ITB) in the JHMC website, PhilGEPS, and conspicuous places reserved for this purpose, pursuant to Sections 22 and 21.2 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184 (IRR of R.A. 9184);

WHEREAS, in the opening of bids during the bidding conducted on 10 January 2024, the results are as follows:

WHEREAS, Felvic Enterprises passed the eligibility requirements during the bid opening and thus, was further subjected to a detailed bid evaluation by the Technical Working Group (TWG) and End-user. A copy of the Abstract of Bids is attached hereto as *Annex "B"*;

WHEREAS, as to the results of the detailed bid evaluation, the BAC declared Felvic Enterprises as non-responsive due to its non-submission of bid indicating the unit prices of construction materials, labor rates, and equipment rentals used in coming up with the bid as required in the Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents and Annex D of the Bidding Documents, and insufficient details specified in the Detailed Unit Price Analysis (DUPA) such as no quantity and unit of measurement per items of work as required in the Guidelines in preparing the DUPA, Annex B of Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, the BAC considered **Guava Construction** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) that would be subjected to the post-qualification process. A copy of the Bid Evaluation Report of the End-User and the TWG is attached as **Annex "C"**;

WHEREAS, with the overall result of the post-qualification conducted on 22 January 2024, the BAC declared **Guava Construction** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB). Attached is a copy of the Post-Qualification Report of the TWG and the End-User (*Annex "D"*);

NOW THEREFORE, THE MEMBERS OF THE BAC HEREBY RESOLVED TO RECOMMEND THE AWARD TO GUAVA CONSTRUCTION THE CONSTRUCTION OF THREE (3) RANGER STATIONS AT HAPPY HALLOW, LOAKAN AND HILLSIDE IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION FORTY-THREE THOUSAND SIXTY-ONE PESOS and 16/100 (PHP2,043,061.16).
