### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

This JHMC project is attributed to the 2025 Gender and Development (GAD) plans and programs.

# **A. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Supplier must be an established company with at least 3 years of experience in supplying and installing Christmas Lights and Décor.
- 2. Must submit proof of compliance with Philippine safety standards and/or any certifications
- 3. The proposal must include design layout, detailed cost breakdown, and project timeline.
- 4. All lighting equipment must be outdoor-rated, energy-efficient (preferably LED), and durable for Baguio's climate. Installation must comply with the Philippine Electrical Code (PEC).

# **B. PROJECT TIMELINE**

 Completion of the project delivery, installation, and turnover is within twenty – one (21) calendar days from the issuance of Notice to Proceed (NTP).

#### C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE WINNING BIDDER

# 1. Design and Planning

- Conduct ocular inspection of Camp John Hay in coordination with JHMC.
- Develop and submit a lighting design and layout for approval, reflecting the festive spirit while preserving the ecological and heritage character of the area.
- ✓ Ensure designs are sustainable, energy-efficient, and weather-resistant.

# 2. Supply and Installation

- Provide all necessary materials and equipment, including:
  - ✓ Commercial-grade LED lights (multi-colour and white)
  - ✓ Mounting tools, extension cords, connectors, fasteners, etc.
- Install lighting in the following priority areas (subject to final site mapping):
  - ✓ Main roads and pedestrian walkways
  - ✔ Open parks and forested areas
  - ✓ Key trees and lamp posts
- Use installation methods that do not damage plants, trees, or structures.

# 3. Maintenance and Operation

- Monitor lighting systems regularly throughout the display period.
- ✔ Provide technical support and repair within 24–48 hours of notification.
- Replace damaged or defective components at no additional cost to JHMC.

# 4. Takedown and Site Restoration

- Dismantle all installed lights and accessories after the display period.
- ✔ Restore all locations to their original state.
- Submit final report with documentation (photos, as-built layout, and incident logs if any).

 4, including road to Scout Hill Area and Historical Core.





In Christmas lore, reindeers symbolize safe journeying, endurance, and adventure.


